CS assisted EMRTS with PHEA (Paddy Morgan/Tom Archer), NB assisted transfer of patient (D) into third EA, IV access, analgesia, antiemetic.

Part way through incident, CS became aware duty fire service tactical commander on scene had personal involvement in case insofar as his daughter was patient (B).

I confirmed senior FRS personnel aware (they were already on scene) and updated WAST DCM via control.
