





Highest risk procedure performed by MEDSERVE Wales responders

Every case audited against the Standard Operating Procedure

Key Performance Indicators are used to monitor compliance with SOP and drive improvement



Discuss with 'top cover' if advised by SOP prior to PHEA [80%]

On scene time <30mins for the non-trapped (medically, environmentally or physically) patient [80%]

Time from starting PHEA (time of giving induction agent) to leaving pre-hospital scene in <15mins [80%]

999 call to PHEA time <45mins in trauma patient [50%]

Intubated on first attempt - >90% and three or less attempts [100%]

Bougie or stylet used in all cases [100%]

PHEA checklist used in all cases [100%]

Hypotension of SBP 90mmHg or desaturation of SpO2 <92% with good trace within 5mins of induction ("Transient Complications") in traumatic/non traumatic brain injury [<10%]

PHEA audit form completed in all cases including indication and observations [100%]

Full case review of all cardiac arrests post RSI [100%]
